NO STREET PARKING

ATTENTION HOMEOWNERS

It has come to our attention there are way to many homeowners parking on the street for long periods of time.

Below is the Special Assessment guidelines

Special Assessment.

Effective June 1, 2008, the Special Assessment for following violations shall be increased to \$250 for the initial and repeated violations and an additional \$250 for each month thereafter that the Owner remains in violation:

- 1. Overnight parking in the street from 11 pm 7 am.
- 2. Parking on the grass at anytime. This includes one or more wheels or straddling the grass between the street and sidewalk.
- 3. Overnight parking of boats, trailers, or other recreational vehicles except as allowed in garages or other areas that have been approved by the ARC.
- 4. Parking large commercial vehicles too large to fit in the garage in our subdivision.

THE EXCEPTION WOULD BE:

- 1. Short term deliveries to your residence
- 2. For essential emergency vehicles.
- Large trucks, such as moving vans, are allowed when moving.
 (Ex. FedEx, UPS, carpet cleaning, furniture delivery & utility trucks).

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
